Students must submit the following to Logos University

- 1. A copy of a High School diploma, etc. or equivalent, for all levels of Degree Programs. DO NOT send originals.
- 2. Original and sealed Official Transcript from a previous learning institution sent directly to Logos University.
- 3. Students are to be actively involved in a local church.
- 4. Admission to Logos University is subject to approval by the Admissions Committee, whose decision is final.

Items Required for Completing the Application Process

- 1. A completed Application
- 2. \$50 non-refundable application fee made payable to Logos University
- 3. \$25 non-refundable evaluation fee made payable to Logos University
- 4. Transcripts: Official Transcripts and High School Transcripts
- 5. A current photograph of applicant (alone and preferable 2x2)

Upon Receipt of the above items, Logos University will ascertain proficiency to determine placement in the highest program, and provide the students with an evaluation letter outlining their course of study for the major they have chosen. Because we are a Christian University, all Applicants must have in their educational portfolio a minimum of 30 Credit Hours of Bible/Theology on the undergraduate or graduate level in addition to the requirements for their program. Students who do not have the prerequisite hours may be eligible for Advanced Standing through Life and Ministry Experience Credit and by taking our Basic Biblical Knowledge Exam for up to a maximum of 30 semester hours of credit. There are forms available on the website (www.logos.edu) for this purpose. When applying for admission, those students who desire Advanced Standing should request this option in the cover letter. All information submitted for Life and Ministry Experience must be verifiable. Any shortage of hours for the prerequisite will be added to the length of the graduate program.
